

COVID-19 VISITATION POLICIES

As caregivers, we know the importance of social connection and the healing properties of spending quality time together. The highly transmissible nature of COVID-19 has presented us all with difficult challenges when it comes to seeing our loved ones, and we thank our patients, residents and families for their patience and understanding as we do everything we can to limit the spread of the virus.

General Visitation Guidelines

- Outdoor visitation remains the safest, preferred option, but indoor visitation is allowed.
- When new COVID-19 cases are detected within a location among patients, residents or staff, visitation will
 continue unless directed by health officials.
- Social distancing of at least six feet is encouraged throughout the duration of a visit with other visitors and employees.
- Masks will be required at all times when county Community Transmission rates are at substantial or above. We are working closely with local health officials to monitor these rates and will have signage posted at our front entrance clearly indicating whether masks are required or optional in our communities and centers.
 - o Oregon, Washington and California communities and centers will continue to require visitors to wear masks regardless of county Community Transmission rates.
- We are asking that if you are experiencing symptoms of respiratory illness, have tested positive for COVID, or have had known exposure to someone who has tested positive, that you please postpone your visit.
